*AtoBe Venture Creators

AtoBe Venture Creators is a program in which we teach our participants how to take a good technological idea and develop it into an up and running start-up company.

We mobilize leading specialists and experienced start-up entrepreneurs to share their knowledge through a series of 10 lectures and weekly assignments.

Throughout the course, participants build: a financial model, business plan, a beta product, market research, 4-minute professional pitch, and more around their technological idea. At the program's graduation party, we host a Demo Day, where the best pitches are presented to VC's and angel investors.

This is knowledge-sharing at its best, with industry leaders sharing their experience and insights with the next generation. In addition to lectures by renowned entrepreneurs, there is a practical component, which consists of mentors presenting entrepreneurs with weekly real-world assignments in preparation for launching their start-ups.
